Pre-Anesthetic Blood Screen Evaluation

To assure maximum safety for your pet we recommend a pre-anesthetic blood screen before surgery. This blood screen will detect anemia, infection, kidney or liver disease, and other problems that might increase the risk of anesthetic for your pet. Most anesthetics are removed from the body through the kidney and liver; therefore, it is important that these organs are healthy. It is also important that patients have a normal blood cell count to promote proper tissue healing. If all these tests are normal, it does not guarantee that your pet will not have an anesthetic reaction, but it does tell us that your pet is healthy and in a low-risk category. The fee for this added protection is **\$97.15. If your pet is over the age of 6 years old, These test are required no exceptions.**
